- **Updated Passenger Train Schematics.** New emergency schematics for a number of passenger railroads operating in the United States and Canada.
- **Freight Railroad Participation.** All Class I railroads in the United States and Canada as well as numerous regional rail carriers are continuing to update their participation in OREIS™. This includes faster download times for railroad tank car verification.
- **Incident Alert and Messaging Notification.** OREIS™ 7.0, through the inclusion of latitude/longitude positioning and recent integrations with numerous emergency service architectures sets the stage for an incident alert and messaging notification network for registered OREIS™ agencies.

The release of OREIS™ 7.0 reaffirms Operation Respond's pledge to provide critical information and incident data to our nation's first responders.
